

DRESS CODE

Proper dress plays a very important part in the dignity and atmosphere of a school. As Torah students, girls and boys should reflect standards in their dress and appearance.

Preschool

Boys:

- **Pants or shorts are allowed**
- **Shirts may be with or without a collar and of any color**
- **Yarmulka and tzitzis should be worn at all times**
- **Proper footwear; in the interest of safety, Crocs and sandals are discouraged**

Girls:

- **Dresses, skirts and jumpers of any color are allowed**
- **Shirts should not be sleeveless**
- **Tights or socks should be worn**
- **Proper footwear; in the interest of safety, Crocs and sandals are discouraged**

Kindergarten – 5th Grade

Boys:

- **Only dark solid color pants or slacks; no denim, cargo pants or shorts**
- **Shirts with collars and buttons all the way down with no pictures or writing on them.
(Polo-type shirts are also acceptable)**
- **Sweatshirts and sweaters may be dark colors, without writing or designs on them.**
- **Yarmulka and tzitzis must be worn at all times.**
- **Boys' hair styles must be neat and trim, and should not hang over the ears.**
- **Caps may only be worn at recess, not in the building.**
- **Bar Mitzvah age boys are expected to wear formal hats and jackets during davening at school.**
- **T-shirts, jerseys, jewelry of any kind, and short pants are all unacceptable.**
- **Proper footwear only. No Crocs or sandals allowed.**

Girls:

- “Tag” plaid or navy pleated skirts or jumpers
- Blouses or Polo-type shirts (light blue, white, navy blue).
- All sweaters, vests and pullovers may be navy blue only without writing or designs on them
- Undershirts must also comply with school shirt colors.
- Knee socks must be worn at all times and shoes must have backs on them.
- Girls are not allowed to wear t-shirts.
- Girls are not allowed to wear makeup or nail polish, as this is all part of appropriate Tznius.
- No girl will be allowed to attend class without adherence to the dress code.
- Proper footwear only. No Crocs, open back/toe shoes or sandals allowed.

6th – 8th grade**Boys:**

- All above dress code policies apply
- Bar Mitzvah age boys are expected to wear formal hats and jackets during davening at school.

Girls:

- All above dress code policies apply
- Button-Down Blouses only in the colors listed above and must be buttoned at least to the second button from the top.
- Undershirts must also comply with school shirt colors.

Children's parents will be notified the first time a uniform offense takes place and the second time the parents will be called and asked to either bring an appropriate uniform or take the child home. In this case, any absence will be unexcused for the day. Parents, as well as anyone designated to pick up a student, or visitors who are known to the parents and visiting on their behalf, are asked to be told to respect our school as well and dress according to Orthodox tradition. It is very important that everyone realizes that one must respect the standards of the school.
